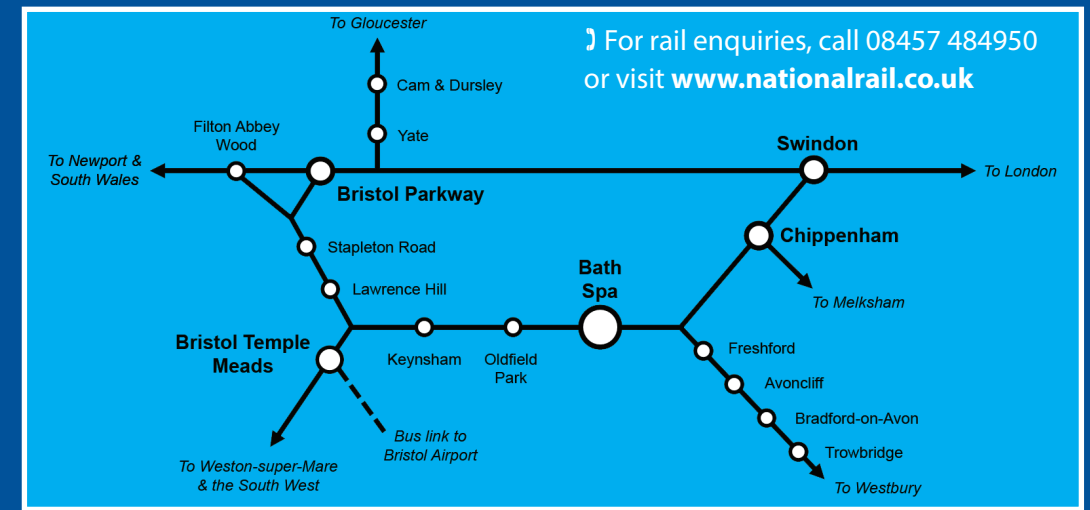


Your local cycle network
