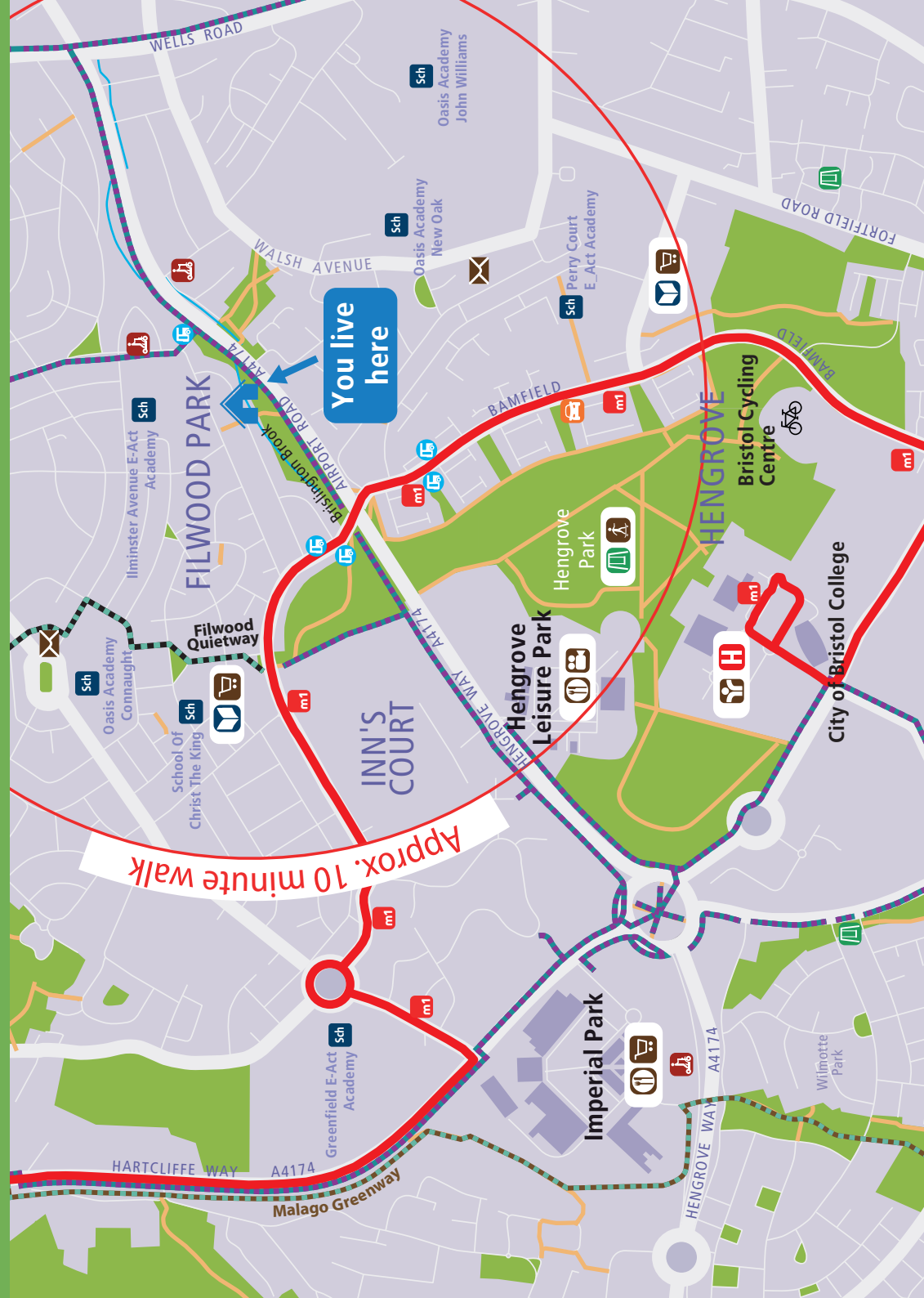

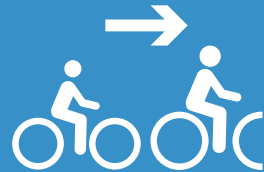
Borrow a bike

If you are new to cycling and would like to give it a go, we have a range of quality bikes for you to borrow for up to 4 weeks. Pedal, folding and e-bikes are available.



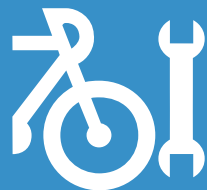
Training
