## **Springfield Papers**

Springfield Business Papers are an SME based in Warmley which specialise in paper supplies and print/design services with particular focus on the public and education sectors.

As part of a project to reduce the overall environmental impact of their operations, which also included installation of solar panels to provide heat and power for their building, they worked with South Gloucestershire Council's Business Engagement team to identify grant funding opportunities.

As result South Gloucestershire helped to provide 4 electric vehicle charge points to support Springfield's newly acquired fleet of plug in hybrid company vehicles which replaced a number of older diesel powered cars and SUVs.

Alongside this, they were also supported the provision of new shower facilities for cyclists and the purchase of 2 electric pool bikes. The overall impact has been considerably reduced carbon footprint, lower fleet and fuel costs and an increase in cycling amongst staff.
